

BLAZE Student Ministry Conduct Agreement

Authority:

Students who choose to participate at Shadycrest Baptist Church activities agree to follow the instructions of leaders and adult workers. Parents also agree to support these rules for the safety and morale of the student ministry. Students must obey these guidelines and exhibit respect toward adult leaders and other students in order to remain at any student ministry activity.

Rules:

1. At no time will student participant engage in inappropriate language.

(Cursing is not something that will be tolerated!)

2. Student participant will at all times wear clothing that is appropriate to each activity. Please wear attire that brings glory to our Heavenly Father.

(Dress in a Christ Like Fashion.) During Swimming- Guys: No Speedo's Girls: No Bikini's (Unless you wear a T-shirt as a covering.)

3. No Alcohol. Tobacco or drugs of any kind will be tolerated during a student event, trip, Activity or at X-Treme.

4. At no time will student participant engage in violent behavior toward other students or toward themselves.

5. Public displays of affection are not allowed during Student ministry trips, activities or at BLAZE Bible Study. Examples: Holding hands, kissing, and other forms of affection are considered inappropriate. Dating students will be separated on trips if any problem arises and if this does not solve the situation both parties will be sent home at the parent's expense.

6. Each Participant attending a meeting or event is expected to remain until the conclusion of the event. If someone must leave early it must be cleared with their parents and with Clint.

Discipline:

Our leaders are expected to discipline students in gentleness, love and with fairness. We will use a "3 strike" system for most rule violations and inappropriate behavior. After three strikes or verbal warnings have been issued, the student will be sent home with the parent's notification. It is our desire for all students to be given ample opportunity to rectify their behavior but at a set point disciplinary action will be taken. If major disciplinary action is taken it may be appropriate for a student and their parents to be taken before the Student committee for reinstatement into future student activities.

WE desire our activities to be safe, holy, and centered on God. Please do your best to observe these rules and honor God in the process.
